

Step Two: Click on "Notes"





Step Four: In the "Note" box, the Referee getting mileage types "**Mileage yes**" and their mileage amount: (i.e.: **50 miles @ \$.56/mile = \$28.00**). The Referee <u>not</u> getting mileage types: "**Mileage no**". Then <u>each</u> Referees <u>must</u> check the boxes "BillTos" and "Officials".

Step Five: <u>Finally</u>, hit the Blue Floppy Disk icon to the left of the comment box. This is what saves it for the paymaster to see it. If the Referee hits the Red "X", it will delete what was entered.
